Privacy & Rights:

As a federal workstudy student, it is expected and required that you:

- *f* Must refer requests for information about a student, staff, administrative or faculty member your FWS Sepervisor to ensure that you do noto hate any Fairfield University or FWS departmentiative confidentiality policies
