THE INTERNSHIP FOR NON-CERTIFIED TEACHERS

The internship for non-certified teachers provides prospective teachers with an opportunity to do field work in their future profession while pursuing a master's degree or a certificate of advanced study and a concurrent program leading to state certification. This program is offered to graduate students in several certification programs.

The responsibilities of the non-certified interns differ according to placement. They include substituting, small group instruction, individual instruction, or assisting in the classroom. In the elementary school setting, interns may be assigned to a mentor teacher in order to gain exposure to an exemplary teacher.

In return for the non-certified intern's work in the school, the school district deposits up to \$15,000 with Fairleigh University. This amount is banked for interns to draw upon for graduate courses

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
