

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HOW/TO USE EPINEPHRINE INJECTION (AUTHORIZED GENERIC OF EPIPENUSP AUTO-INJECTOR, MYLAN

- 1. Remove the epinephrine auto-injector from the clear carrier tube.
- 2. Grasp the auto-injector in your st with the orange tip (needle end) pointing downward.

- 3. With your other hand, remove the blue safety release by pulling straight up.
- 4. Swing and push the auto-injector rmly into the middle of the outer thigh until it 'clicks'.
- 5. Hold rmly in place for 3 seconds (count slowly 1, 2, 3).
- 6. Remove and massage the injection area for 10 seconds.
- 7, Call 911 and get emergency medical help right away

HOW TO USE IMPAX EPINEPHRINE INJECTION (AUTHORIZED GENERIC OF ADRENAC®),CK USP AUTO-INJECTOR, IMPAX LABORATORIES

- Remove epinephrine auto-injector from its protective carrying case.
- 2. Pull off both blue end caps: you will now see a red tip.
- 8. Grasp the auto-injector in your st with the red tip pointing downward.
- 4. Put the red tip against the middle of the outer thigh at a 90-degree angle, perpendicular to the thigh.
- 5. Press down hard and hold rmly against the thigh for approximately 10 seconds.
- 6. Remove and massage the area for 10 seconds.
- 7. Call 911 and get emergency medical help right away
